

ORDER


Judge Luann Cooperrider, Judge of Perry County Probate and Juvenile Court Divisions of Common Pleas Court hereby makes the following order. In light of the fact that the Governor of the State of Ohio, Michael Dewine, has declared a State of Emergency (Executive Order 2020-OID) limits gathering of people and other orders. The Governor has also issued a Stay at Home Order effective March 23, 2020.

In light of these orders and the fact that the Governor has declared that legal services are essential, the Probate and Juvenile Court remain vital amid this COVID-19 crisis and will hereby remain open with limited access for individuals into those offices. The court will continue said hearings that are deemed unnecessary and reschedule. The court hours will remain the same, 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. There is only one door of entrance to the Courthouse, ground level entrance from Brown Street. All individuals are required to sign in and sanitize at the handwashing station at that entrance.

As further precaution the court is ordering that the temperatures of each employee be taken each morning and that each employee stay home if they are feeling ill.

The court will remain open for vital services that are essential for the operations and safety of the citizens of Perry County.

It is so ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED.
